1. Our GDPR principles

- we will process all personal data fairly and lawfully
- we will only process personal data for specified and lawful purposes
- we will endeavour to hold relevant and accurate personal data, and where practical, we will keep it up to date
- we will not keep personal data for longer than is necessary
- we will keep all personal data secure
- we will ensure that no data is transferred to any other parties

2. GDPR compliance

- We will implement the relevant policies and practices to ensure we protect any data handled by ourselves – for our employees, customers and suppliers specifically including the following:
 - . employees will be made aware of the GDPR restrictions and obligations within it as may be relevant to them, with the relevant training provided as necessary.

3. Our GDPR actions to date

- We have appointed a Data Protection Officer
- We are continually reviewing our policies, including our Data Protection Policy.
- We undertake regular reviews of the personal data we store, manage, maintain, collect, process and control.
- We provide training to all employees and generally raising the awareness and importance of GDPR to our business and their individual responsibilities arising from this.
